- The Award's mission is to raise global awareness for exemplary policies, educating and inspiring policy makers, civil society and the general public.
- The World Future Policy Award is unique because it honours policies, not people.
- Laws, policies and frameworks can be national, subnational, regional or local in nature.

Nomination deadline is 15th February 2025.

The finalists will be announced in spring 2025. The winning policies will be celebrated at a high-level award ceremony jointly with the International Union for Conservation of Nature at the IUCN World Conservation Congress in Abu Dhabi in October 2025.
